ONLINE WATER PAYMENTS—NOW AVAILABLE

The City of Atwater is now providing residents an easy & convenient way to pay Water & Sewer Billing. Residents may pay with **VISA, MASTERCARD, DISCOVER CREDIT CARD** or **DEBIT CARD**. Residents can make payments online any time of the day or night. It only takes a few minutes to make a payment.

TO MAKE AN ONLINE PAYMENT FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE STEPS

1. Visit City website at www.atwater.revtrak.net
2. Select "Utilities"
3. Enter your last name & account number
4. Click "Buy Now"
5. When all fees are in shopping cart, click "Go to Checkout". If a "New Customer", select "I am a new customer". Enter your e-mail address & "Sign In". If a "Returning Customer", select "I am a New Customer". Enter your e-mail address & password. Select "Sign In".
6. Enter your billing & payment information. Create a password if required.
7. Verify information for accuracy & select "Complete Order".
8. **Payment will be processed & receipt can be viewed & printed.** A receipt will be sent to the e-mail address provided during account set up.
9. "Logout".

TRICK OR TREAT! Safety Tips!!



Remind kids not to enter a strange house.

Make sure older kids go out with friends. Younger children should be accompanied by an adult. If you live in rural area, offer all kids a ride in the car.

Set a time limit for children to treat or trick. Together, map out a safe route so you know where they'll be. Remind them not to take shortcuts through backyards, alleys or parks.

Try to get kids to trick or treat while it is still light out. If it is dark, make sure the children are carrying flashlights that work.

One way to keep trick or treaters from digging in while they're still out is to feed them a meal beforehand.

Check out all treats at home in a well lighted place.

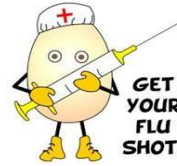
